C.Y.C.L.E aims to:

- ✿ Extend older children and provide opportunities to form relationships, in a supportive and enriching environment.
- ✿ Meet the social needs of children by providing group activities while still giving children the freedom to take the lead in their own play.
- ✿ Develop positive learning dispositions, self-help skills and the independence required for successful transitions to school.
- ✿ Give children positive and supportive guidance with their communication skills, actions, behaviour, respect and other social and cultural values.
- ✿ Extend children's understanding and theories of the world around them through stimulating experiences based on their interests.
- ✿ Identify and expand learning opportunities and strengths, through ongoing evaluation and planning.
- ✿ Provide Playcentre whānau with a childcare option that fits within the Playcentre philosophy and complements our parent-run sessions.



Criteria/Caregiver Information

- Your child needs to be settled, toilet trained and attending 2 general sessions at their home centre.
- Parents need to hold Course 2, or be actively working towards it. *In special circumstances, enrolments not meeting criteria may be accepted. This will be decided on a case-by-case basis.*
- Return by 1pm to contribute to the end of session clean up.
- If you claim the 20 hours ECE funding there is no fee for C.Y.C.L.E, however donations are greatly appreciated. **Details on back of flyer.**
- Make sure your child has at least one change of clothes, a plastic bag, lunch and a drink for each session - no lollies, chocolate or nuts please.
- Please ensure **ALL** of your child's belongings are named.
- Occasionally you will be asked to bring in an item for an upcoming session activity – your contributions help keep our costs down.
- Each session has one trip every term that you may need to pay for.
- If an alternative person will be collecting your child from C.Y.C.L.E, the supervisors need to be advised beforehand, and they will need to contribute to clean up.
- C.Y.C.L.E has a group Facebook page on which relevant notices are posted.
- Photos taken on session are used for group observations, and occasionally promotional purposes within Te Akoranga Playcentre Association - these are emailed out to caregivers.
- Once a term you are required to remain on session as caregiver help to support and assist the supervisors (see the team for tasks).
